This is the first week of your home learning. This week you have a paper pack but from next week you will find your week's learning on the website. Remember it is very important you do this learning—you are not on holiday!!



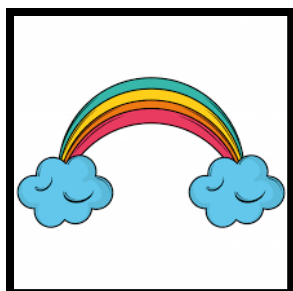
