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## Key Vocabulary

Islam	A religion founded by Muhammad (PBUH).
Muslim	A person who follows the religion of Islam.
Muhammad (PBUH)	An Arab religious leader and the person who started Islam
Allah	The one and only God in Islam.
Iman	Belief
Shahadah	The Muslim profession of faith ('there is no god but Allah, and Muhammad is the messenger of Allah').
Prayer	The act of asking God or another spiritual being to use his or her power.
God	The eternal Supreme Being who created and preserves all things.
