### Literacy

Our focus has been on the story **Rumble in the Jungle**. Whilst exploring the story children have been practicing using full sentences to describe the animals from the story– concentrating on adding adjectives. Children have written sentences about an animal from the story. They used capital letters, finger space and concentrated on letter formation.

### Maths

Children have continued to develop the understanding that all numbers are made up of smaller numbers.

They have explored and noticed the different compositions of 5 in a variety of activities.

For example 5 can be composed of 4 and 1 or 3 or 2 and 2 or 5 and 0.
