What I already know...

How to use a digital device to take a photograph and which tools will change the photograph. I have also learnt what makes a good photograph.

What I will learn...

Learners will develop their understanding of how digital images can be changed and edited, and how they can then be resaved and reused. They will consider the impact that editing images can have, and evaluate the effectiveness of their choices.

- How to rotate and crop an image.
- How to filter an image with appropriate effects.
- How parts of a photo can be cloned.
- How to create my own image deciding what editing skills are necessary.
